

The beneficiaries of this year's carnival are:

SHAFTESBURY COMMUNITY HEALTH ASSOCIATION - CASTLE HILL HOUSE We are a home for the elderly caring for 17 residents, all of varying degrees of frailty. We have a dedicated team of staff who look after their needs. We are a non-profit making organisation and as we have now been open ten years, refurbishment and redecorating is now an ongoing commitment. As we are to be a beneficiary of some carnival funds, it would be lovely to have a room refurbished with this gift.

ROYAL BRITISH LEGION - POPPY APPEAL: The Royal British Legion is the largest ex-service charity with a total membership of 750,000. Nationally the Legion has a dependency of almost 18 million people coped by 20,000 Legion voluntary workers handling innumerable cases of hardship and distress on a local basis. Shaftesbury and District branch has attended to 17 cases in the area so far this year. They have included help with medical convalescence, financial advice and help, psychological support and the remedy of loneliness and the initiation or assessment review of War Pensions. The annual poppy appeal funds the Legion's work. The poppy is a symbol of respect for those who have died defending our freedom, justice and democracy, not just an act of giving but also saying "thank you".

SHAFTESBURY ARTS CENTRE: The Art's Centre have a membership of 500 who belong to a variety of sub-groups covering all aspects from Drama, Calligraphy to Yoga and Art. There is also a gallery which constantly houses exhibitions of work by local people. The Phoenix room is used by many of the Art's Centre's groups for meetings or smaller functions and it is regularly hired by outside groups. This room is in need of major refurbishment and we are very grateful to the carnival committee for making us one of their beneficiaries, helping us in this work.

SHAFTESBURY DISTRICT GUIDES: There are approximately 70-80 girls in Brownie and Guide units in Shaftesbury and Motcombe. The Guiders are all volunteers and are always willing to give of their time generously. Camping is an important activity and we are fortunate enough to own camping equipment which is kept in a rented store. Many of our tents are getting old and need replacing and this is one of the main reasons we have requested money from the carnival committee.

Shaftesbury Carnival Committee has also purchased a camera for the **BARTON** HILL PLAY GROUP.

Please give generously during the carnival week's events and on carnival day itself so that our beneficiaries can be well supported.
